Spring Break Art Camp policies and procedures:

- Campers must be at least NINE (9) years of age.
- Drop off is from 8:45 - 9:00am.
- Children need to be picked up promptly between 3 and 3:15pm.
- Children should not attend if they are experiencing any symptoms of illness or have tested positive for COVID-19, if anyone in their household is sick or has tested positive for COVID-19, or if they have been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- gallupARTS will provide drinking water for children, and water bottles are encouraged.
- Children must bring their own snacks and lunch (with lunch being required).
- Campers should dress in a manner that allows them to participate in all activities. Smocks/old T-Shirts are encouraged for morning sessions. Walking shoes, sunscreen, hats, jackets as needed depending on weather are encouraged for Walking Field Trips.
- gallupARTS is not responsible for personal property.
- gallupARTS is not equipped and will not distribute medication to any person under the age of 18. If a child requires medication while in gallupARTS' care (including an inhaler), a parent or guardian must be present to administer that medication. Children's medications will not be stored by gallupARTS.
- Children are expected to behave in a manner respectful of themselves, each other, instructors, craft materials, and the space.
- In case of an emergency, gallupARTS will first call provided emergency contact(s). If the emergency is life-threatening, gallupARTS will first call 911, and then call emergency contact(s).
- gallupARTS reserves the right to refuse service to any child/family who violates its stated policies/procedures.
